APAW 2010 ART & PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST



In commemoration of our city's Centennial, the Association for the Protection of Angell Woods is hosting the first APAW art and photography contest with 2 first prizes of \$300 ea.

DIRECTIVES for APAW 2010 ART CONTEST:

- Contest is open to all artists 18 years of age and older who are residents of Beaconsfield as of January 1, 2010.
- Artists are permitted to submit a maximum of two (2) drawings, paintings, sculptures, or two (2) photographs depicting the theme of Angell Woods.
- All entries must be entirely the work of the entrant.
- Artwork must not exceed 60 inches in one direction, unframed.
- Unframed work is accepted however the artist is responsible for framing the work before it is put on display during the one-week exhibition and, if selected, at the Angell Woods Nature Walk and Picnic on September 18 (rain date September 19).
- Directors and immediate family members of the APAW Board of Directors are not permitted to enter this contest.
- Works to be judged by an impartial jury must be brought to Centennial Hall between 9:30 a.m. and NOON Thursday August 26. All paintings must be picked up between 8:00 a.m. and NOON on Friday, August 27.
- A collection of the entries will be exhibited for one week – exact dates and location TBA.
- Artists are to sign a waiver to release APAW and the City of Beaconsfield from any damage that may occur while the works are in possession of APAW or the City of Beaconsfield.
